**LESLIE FEINBERG** is an internationally renowned fiction writer, historian, and advocate for transgender rights. Leslie, though born female, prefers the use of gender-neutral pronouns "hir" and "ze." Feinberg considers hir fiction writing to be an extension of political work, a way of reaching out to people who otherwise "[could not] understand an oppression they themselves had never experienced." After winning the Stonewall Book Award for hir groundbreaking novel *Stone Butch Blues*, and leading the annual Camp Trans activist gathering, Feinberg continues to tour around the world as a public speaker, advocating for trans rights and educating the public about the broad spectrum of gender expressions in our society. Hir most recent novel is titled *Drag King Dreams*, and hir ongoing column on queer political history, "Lavender & Red," can be found in the newspaper *Workers World*.
